## All Will Be Well

Good morning church! It's good to be back and well on my way to recovering from weight loss surgery. What a weird world I've entered. I've thought quite a bit about trust and faith and how the two are closely linked. Being a pastor, I can't but help look at life through a theological lens.

I came to the realization I wanted to attend to my health in a big serious way—and bring out the big guns so to speak. I wanted to reduce my risk of stroke, lower my blood pressure, and high cholesterol, eliminate diabetes, live longer, and have more energy to better become the person God created me to be.

A big opportunity for doing things differently, doing things better, for grace and renewal lay in the hands of my surgeon. I trusted him because I believed he had the knowledge and skill and experience to perform the surgery that would give me basically a new life. Kinda like salvation, in the spiritual life.

I had to trust in my surgeon with all my might and lean not on my own understanding and Dr. Hovey would direct my path. This procedure was beyond my capacity to fully understand and to go forward I would need to trust and have faith in my surgeon.

I went in the morning to my surgery and got prepped, which wasn't all that different from my scope on my knee the summer before. When I finally came to late that evening, everything was different. It was late in the evening and my room was dark, with people coming and going all through the night. It hurt, I felt nauseous, I was only partially aware, making everything seem like a dream. My nurse was so kind, coming in speaking softly, helping me up, tucking me back in. But in spite of her, the whole night had a nightmarish quality.

I went home and was introduced to nausea, persistent, ever-present nausea. I asked a friend if this was as bad as pregnancy, she said, no it's worse! Eating and drinking remains problematic, I'm now sensitive to dairy, and have low levels of energy. One month down, 11 to go. But I keep telling myself, all will be well, and all will be well, in all manner of things, all will be well.

When I feel insecure, I reach out to people going through this experience with me—friends, and doctors and staff. I lean into my reassurance that many people have been through what I'm facing, and I'll come out on the other side as well.

This whole experience has been a model of life with God. Sometimes life has big changes, and can be disorienting, confusing, and uncomfortable. But I'm never left alone to my own devices to figure things out. I'm surrounded by people who love and care for me. And I'm in the hands of my Healer, the ultimate Physician, who I trust with my life and who's saved my life, and who brings new life daily.

So, I keep on keeping on and look forward to a day without nausea. Please Lord! ☺

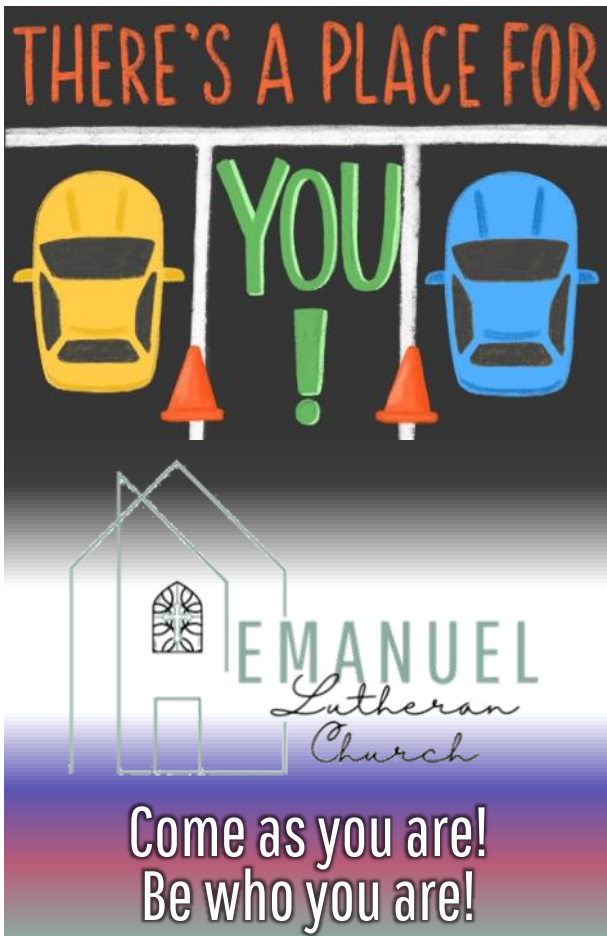
